Outcomes:

Content:

Cabin Drill

- Seating, steering, mirrors and trailer
- Vehicle and Caravan Inspection / Power Checks

Road Craft

- Travelling distances, safety buffers, driving to conditions, speed limits
- Low ground clearance, high centre of gravity
- Braking early, linear, threshold and split surface
- · Line and cornering principles, entry speeds and corner balance
- Trailer balance, correct gears, load shift

Unsealed surfaces

- Correct gear selection, area of best grip, surface changes
- Suitable speeds for cruising, cornering and intersections
- Safe positioning, threshold and emergency braking

Overtaking

- Correct positioning, forward observations & hazards
- Planning for long load, oversize and road trains
- Positive overtaking procedures & repositioning

Caravan Towing

- Distribution of weight
- Compliance of vehicle and caravan
- Hitching and unhitching
- Safety chains and shackles
- Reversing and manoeuvring; varying exercises including some complex manoeuvres

Investment:

• \$950 + GST per session (up to 2 participants)

Assessment:

- Pre-training assessment to ascertain the skill gap
- Final assessment will include observation of real or simulated processes and procedures, questioning on underpinning knowledge and skills and consideration of evidence of required attitudes

Driver Requirement:
