



Vehicle Cleaning Kit and Preparation checklist

Hand wash - Before and after any meal breaks you and the client(s) are required to wash hands with "soap on tap" with running water or alcohol wipes
Hand gel: Used when soap and water are not available
A spray bottle with methylated spirits and a cloth: The steering wheel, door handles, hand brake, gear stick and key of start button must be wiped prior to a new driver taking control of the vehicle
Tissues and disposal bag. Any tissues used must be disposed of immediately
Windows are required to be down to allow airflow





Vehicle Cleaning Checklist

Use this template to ensure you're effectively cleaning your vehicle to minimise the spread of germs and bacteria. You can print off copies to keep in the vehicle.

Seat and adjusting levers
Door handles – inside and out
DMR and two way radio cords, handset and volume and channel dial
Gear knobs and Hand Brake
Mirror and mirror controls
Wiper stalks
Radio Dials
Turn Signal stalks
Bonnet and fuel cap release
Steering wheel
Temperature controls and air flow controls
Seatbelts inc latch and buckle
Key and start buttons
Fuel nozzle when refueling
Lockable free wheeling hubs
